Dear Senator Cruz and Congressman Roy,

On behalf of the more than 2.3 million members of AMAC – the Association of Mature American Citizens – I write to express our support for the Personalized Care Act of 2021, S. 153 and H.R. 725.

AMAC has long supported the use of Health Savings Accounts (HSA) as a means of increasing financial freedom for Americans as they manage their health care expenditures. Our members regularly tell us that they desire more personal control over their health care, free from government intrusion and mandates.

This legislation uncomplicates health care and puts Americans in charge of their care by expanding HSAs to pay for direct primary care, health sharing ministries, insurance premiums and medications. This expansion of options for HSAs is precisely what is needed in health care – the opportunity to tailor care specific to an individual’s needs with tax-free dollars.
